GP MRI REBATABLE ITEMS

Patient 16 years and over

MRI Head (63551)

- unexplained seizure(s)
- unexplained chronic headache with suspected intracranial pathology

MRI Cervical Spine

- cervical radiculopathy (63554), or
- cervical spine trauma (63557)

MRI Knee (63560)

- Following acute knee trauma for patients 16-49 with:
- inability to extend the knee suggesting the possibility of acute meniscal tear
 - clinical findings suggesting acute anterior cruciate ligament tear

GP MRI REBATABLE ITEMS

Patients under the age of 16

MRI Head (63507)

- unexplained seizure(s)
- unexplained headache where significant pathology is suspected
- paranasal sinus pathology which has not responded to conservative therapy

MRI Spine (63510) *

- significant trauma
- unexplained neck or back pain with associated neurological signs
- unexplained back pain where significant pathology is suspected

MRI Knee (63513)

- Internal joint derangement

MRI Hip (63516) *

- suspected septic arthritis
- suspected slipped capital femoral epiphysis
- suspected Perthes disease)

MRI Elbow (63519) *

- significant fracture or avulsion injury is suspected that will change management

MRI Wrist (63522) *

- suspected scaphoid fracture

* Following a general x-ray
